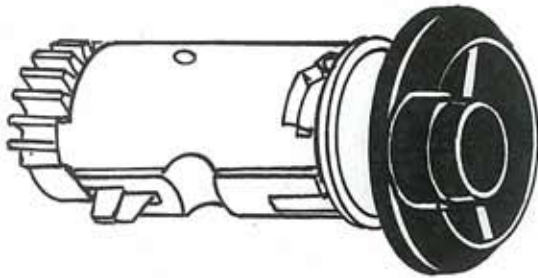

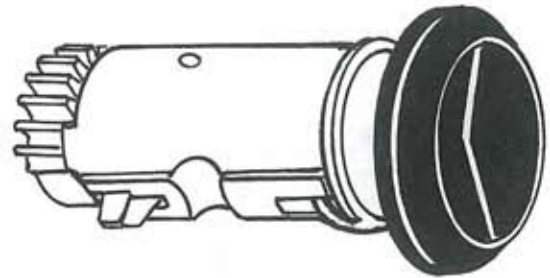

General Motors and Briggs & Stratton have engineered a new style steering column ignition lock for manual transmission Buick Regals, Pontiac Grand Prixes and Oldsmobile Cutlass Supremes. The lock has a push button on the knob face that must be depressed to release the key from the lock. This knob replaces the finger switch key release previously found on the steering column. This lock was put into service April 1988.

This lock is for manual transmission models only. The **700756** is similar to the **700556** model used on automatic transmission models as shown below.
